

## ATTENDANCE AREA ADVISORY COMMITTEES

In order to increase communications with the public and provide citizen involvement in problem solving at the attendance area level, the School Board encourages the formation of citizens school advisory committees composed of people representative of the attendance area served by the school.

Advisory committees should be “ad hoc” groups assembled to address a particular question or problem by working with the principal in gathering and sharing information.

The principal is responsible for selecting the advisory committee in such a manner as to insure representation of as many points of view as possible around the matter in question.

Upon completion of the task for which the advisory committee was assembled, that committee shall be dissolved. Advisory committees should not continue beyond the end of any school year except to complete a task that might carry over into the summer.
