

SCHOOL BOARD MEETING AGENDAS

The Superintendent of Schools in consultation with the School Board Chairperson shall prepare the agenda for each Board meeting. Whenever a matter involving policy consideration is placed on the agenda, the Superintendent shall advise the Board of any policies previously adopted affecting such matter. Any member of the Board may submit items for the agenda either to the Chairperson or the Superintendent.

Individuals wishing to place an item on the Board agenda shall advise the Superintendent of Schools one week in advance. The agenda shall allow for the recognition and introduction of guests, together with remarks for the good of the school district by any Board member.

Items of business may not be suggested from the floor for action at the same meeting except by 2/3 majority vote of the Board members present. Discretion should be exercised by Board members on bringing matters before the School Board that could be resolved through administrative channels.

The Board may choose not to deal with every agenda item.

Consistent with RSA 91-A:3 and the laws pertaining to student and family privacy rights, the Board will not place any matter on the public meeting agenda that is to be properly discussed in a non-public session. This shall not preclude the Board from giving notice of its intent to hold or enter into a non-public session and the statutory reason for doing such.

Board Members shall be expected to read the information provided them and to contact the Superintendent to request additional information that may be deemed necessary to assist them in their decision-making responsibilities.

When the final agenda has been established, it will be made available to the public, upon request. Members of the public who wish to speak at Board meetings regarding an agenda item are encouraged to contact the Superintendent prior to the Board meeting.

Additionally, the Board reserves the right to limit public discussion at Board meetings to agenda items only.
