

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION IN BOARD MEETINGS

All meetings of the Fall Mountain Regional School Board shall be open to the public. All actions of the Fall Mountain Regional School Board shall be taken openly and the deliberation leading to Board action shall likewise be conducted openly. The public is invited to attend Fall Mountain Regional School Board meetings and will be given limited time to voice opinions or concerns.

The Fall Mountain Regional School Board reserves the right to meet in a Non-public Session as provided for in RSA 91-A:3. No action shall be taken by the Fall Mountain Regional School Board while it is in Non-public Session. All action shall be taken in an open meeting.

The Fall Mountain Regional School Board recognizes its responsibility to conduct the business of the district in an orderly and efficient manner and will, therefore, require reasonable controls to regulate public presentations to the Fall Mountain Regional School Board.

A person wishing to place an item on the School Board agenda must submit the item in writing to the Superintendent one week prior to the meeting date. A person wishing to be heard by the Fall Mountain Regional School Board shall first be recognized by the Chairperson. He/she shall then identify himself/herself and proceed with his/her comments as briefly as the subject permits. The Chairperson is responsible for the orderly conduct of the meeting and shall rule on such matters as the time to be allowed for public discussion, the appropriateness of the subject being presented and the suitability of the time for such a presentation.

Persons appearing before the Board are reminded, as a point of information, that members of the Board are without authority to act independently as individuals in official matters. Thus, questions may be directed to individual Board members, but answers must be deferred pending consideration and/or vote by the full Board.
