

NEW BOARD MEMBER ORIENTATION

The magnitude of School Board membership calls for knowledge of and orientation to many areas of information and understandings. Under the guidance of experienced board members and the Administration, orientation will be provided to new board members through activities including the following:

- a. workshop for new Board members conducted by state and area school board associations
- b. discussions and visits with the Superintendent and other members of the school staff
- c. opportunity to make use of printed and audio-visual materials on School Board and administrative policies and procedures.

Orientation shall be considered as an ongoing process for all School Board members, and may include such activities as those indicated above and the addition of the following:

- a. attendance at school board and administrative conferences and conventions on a local, area, state, and national basis
- b. exchange of ideas through joint meetings with neighboring school boards.

New board members are requested to thoroughly read the District's Policy Manual and serve their first year on the Policy Committee.
