

SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS

It is the policy of the Fall Mountain Regional School District to provide for safe schools in the district. Schools with lower crime statistics offer students a greater opportunity to pursue educational endeavors successfully. K-8 schools within the district will continue with current acceptable practices and shall request police officer assistance from the town which the school resides when and as needed or required by law. School Resource Officer(s) (SRO's) shall be supported and deployed at any School within our district; fundamentally, logistically, and financially by the district (Funded as a High School budgeted expense). School Resource Officers shall be fully certified law enforcement officers, prior to any assignment into a school, within the jurisdiction of the town which any School resides. The SRO will receive specialized training, if needed, as a School Resource Officer within one year of assignment. School Resource Officers will perform the duties of an SRO as defined by the National Association of School Resource Officers. The SRO evaluation will be completed by the Administration and the Chief on an annual basis.
