

## STUDENT INTERNET SAFETY

The Fall Mountain Regional School District supports the use of the Internet as an educational tool and maintains compliancy with CIPA, N-CIPA, COPPA and FERPA regulations. It enables students, staff, and administrators to access information, research sources, and interact with people and computers throughout the world. The Internet provides a tool to support and enrich curriculum at all levels. Therefore, Internet access will be made available to students in the District for the purposes of communication, research, and education.

It shall be the responsibility of all members of the Fall Mountain Regional School District staff to educate, supervise and monitor appropriate student usage of the online computer network and access to the Internet in accordance with this policy, it's regulations, the Children's Internet Protection Act, the Neighborhood Children's Internet Protection Act and the Protecting Children in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act. The use of the Internet is a privilege, not a right, and inappropriate use can result in a loss of those privileges as well as other disciplinary action.
