

GRADUATION OF HOME EDUCATION STUDENTS

Under ED 315.02 Procedures for the Operation of Home Education Programs and Chapter 193-A-Home Education, children between the ages of 6 and 16 may be eligible for a home-education program contingent upon the completion of the procedures specified in Ed 315. The Fall Mountain Regional School District accepts responsibility for those students who wish to enroll in Fall Mountain Regional High School at the age of 16 or at the beginning of the Junior year (11th grade) and who have followed the matriculation process for home educated students (see Procedure for Participation in the Fall Mountain Regional High School Diploma Program for Home School Students).

The Fall Mountain Regional School District Board does not accept responsibility for the home education programs for students after the age of 16.
