

## STUDENT RELEASE TIME

Generally, all pupils will attend the schools to which they are assigned during all the time the schools are in session as required by law.

Exceptions may be made in circumstances not contrary to law if, in the judgment of the Superintendent, a pupil's best interests will be served. Such exceptions may include, but shall not be limited to: a released-time program for High School students in good standing which includes work-study, modified open campus, and enrollment in other schools for specific purposes; a modified school day/year for pupils whose special circumstances may require an atypical program, and pupils whose well-being requires out-of-school instruction carried out under the auspices and supervision of the District.
