

STUDENT CONDUCT ON BUSES

The Fall Mountain Regional School District recognizes that a school bus is an extension of the classroom, and that students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with established standards for behavior and courtesy.

Cases of improper conduct on buses will be brought to the attention of the Principal of the offending student's school and the Transportation Director, who shall be designated as the Superintendent's designee in accordance with RSA 189:9-a.

It shall be the responsibility of each building Principal in conjunction with the Transportation Director to prepare and disseminate information regarding rules of conduct on buses to all students and parents/guardians in the Principal's school/attendance area.

It shall be the policy of the Fall Mountain Regional School Board to employ audio/video surveillance on school buses in accordance with Policy ECAF.

The Superintendent shall develop procedures as necessary for the implementation of this policy.
