

STUDENT DRUG ABUSE

Legal Drugs:

Drugs which a student has on prescription and carries onto school property for ingestion as prescribed by a doctor, will be kept in the nurse's or principal's office.

Illegal Drugs:

Use, possession or sale of illegal drugs, in any form, is prohibited.

- If a student appears to be under the influence of a substance, parents will be notified by school authorities to remove him/her to his/her home or to medical facilities.
- In severe or emergency cases, the principal will take appropriate action. Parents will be notified of this action and be responsible for expenses.
- Upon reasonable evidence of use, possession or sale of drugs by any student on School District property, appropriate disciplinary action shall be taken. A conference among the parents, student and principal should be held as soon as possible.
- Any student convicted in court for illegally selling drugs on or off campus to students or employees of Fall Mountain Regional School District may be suspended from school pending School Board action.
